Instructions to Authors

Journal owner: The International Journal of Behavioral Science (IJBS) is an academic journal which belongs to the Behavioral Science Research Institute (BSRI), Srinakharinwirot University, Bangkok, Thailand.

Journal Standard: The journal is managed by an editorial board, comprising of professors, experts in various fields and reviewers with doctoral degrees, who have rich experience in conducting and publishing research. Some of the board members are external, working at other universities of Thailand and overseas, while the internal board members work at our institution, BSRI. The editorial team at the BSRI reviews all submitted papers and manages the peer review and publication process. At least two reviewers evaluate each submitted manuscript. The journal follows the double-blind peer review process.

Disseminating period: The International Journal of Behavioral Science (IJBS) is published twice a year- in the months of January and July. For academic dissemination, each volume is open access and is available free of charge. All issues of the IJBS can be downloaded from the following websites:

Submission and Processing of Manuscripts:

1. The IJBS journal accepts research papers, academic review articles, and book reviews only in English language.
2. The submitted manuscript should be in the field of behavioural sciences and humanities, with a focus on human behaviour and research through an interdisciplinary approach. The research methodology should be strong and clearly explained. The paper should also highlight the behavioural science applications/implications of the research.
3. The submission must be an original work, which has not been published previously.
4. A cover letter must be submitted along with the manuscript, specifying the title of the manuscript, author's name, email contact and official address.

5. A committee reviews each submission to the IJBS and then the decision of acceptance/ rejection is given to the author. Accepted papers are sent for peer review.
6. Each submitted work undergoes a rigorous process of double blind peer review process, wherein the submission is reviewed by two experts in the field related to the submitted paper.
7. After the peer review is completed, the editor of IJBS reviews the paper and sends the compiled feedback to the author. Each author is expected to review and edit their submission based on the suggestions and feedback of the editorial team.
8. The final acceptance for publishing in the journal is based on that each manuscript submitted for the IJBS must have been considered and accepted by at least 2 peer reviewers, and also the editorial team of IJBS.
9. Before the submitted manuscript is sent for peer review, the authors need to pay handling fee for publishing with the IJBS. The payment amount (applicable as per the BSRI guidelines) and the payment policy letter would be sent to the author once your submission gets initial acceptance by the IJBS editorial team.

Instructions for Preparation of Manuscripts:

I. The research paper should be based on the APA style format (6th edition). Authors are recommended to adhere to the following guidelines-

- 1) The paper should not exceed 15 pages in length, including the references, tables, and figures.
- 2) Papers should be typed in English on standard A4 size paper (8.5" x 11").
- 3) Single spaced with 1 inch margins on all sides
- 4) Use a font of 12 pt. Times New Roman.
- 5) All submissions should be in Microsoft Word documents.
- 6) The front section of the paper should include:
 - a. Title (recommended 12 words by APA),
 - b. Author name and affiliation,
 - c. Abstract (150- 250 words),
 - d. Key words (3-5) must be specified. (Ideally these should be different from the title).
- 7) Major sections of a research paper should include: an abstract; introduction (mentioning the background and importance of the problem), with a brief literature review, research objectives, conceptual framework (if any), and hypotheses/ research questions; methodology (sample, research instruments, steps of conducting the research); results; discussion and conclusion; and references.
- 8) Important aspects of the paper must display:

- a. A running head for the title of the paper (not more than 50 characters as per APA guidelines).
 - b. All numerical information should follow APA guidelines and be shown with only 2 places after decimals (e.g. 9.73), both in text and in tables and figures.
 - c. All tables and figures must be mentioned in text. The tables and figures should be clear.
- 9) In text citations and the reference style should follow the APA (American Psychological Association) system of citing sources.

II. When submitting the paper, the author of each submission should clearly state the following:

- Title
- Author's name, designation, official address, and contact e-mail.
